## **God Cares About The Little Things – Luke 12:6-7**

*“Are not five sparrows sold for two copper coins? And not one of them is forgotten before God. But the very hairs of your head are all numbered. Do not fear therefore; you are of more value than many sparrows.”*

How many of us have lost our car keys? Or glasses? Or purse? Or wallet? When we lose something like that we can be hesitant to pray about it because we “don't want to bother God with something little.”

God cares enough to number the hairs on your head. This means He cares about things we might otherwise consider beneath His notice!

Scripture commands us to pray without ceasing (1 Thess. 5:17), to pray always (Eph. 6:18), and to pray for everyone (1 Tim. 2:1).

It is through praying for these little things and seeing God answer those prayers that we come to understand the depth of His love and care for us.

The verses we just read tell us that we are of more value than many sparrows. God gave the life of His one and only Son to enable us to have a relationship with Him. That is our value!

We have value because God says we do.
